

Right to a Positive Learning Environment

No belittling or unpleasant conversations compromising the dignity and respect of the participants or faculty will be tolerated. Disregard of dignity and respect of the participants or parents will result in quick non-refundable termination of one's involvement.

Ambassadorship

As a participant at the New York Institute of Dance and Education, you become a living example of everything that is right in the world. You will promote positive solutions to negative situations. You will promote the belief that everyone can win and celebrate the possibility of "yes!" If you are under 18, your parents must embrace all of these principles as well, so we create an environment where your entire family celebrates the success and possibility of good fortune for yourself and everyone around you. Financial Understanding

Please heed to this confidentiality requirement carefully. It is the only way we can ensure a level playing ground for all participants.

Common Courtesy Requirement

By attending the Institute the undersigned, and/or their parent or guardian, agrees that the participant will willingly treat all individuals at the Institute, whether they be staff, parents, classmates, or visitors, with the highest sense of welcome, courtesy and respect. Failure to exercise basic common courtesy could result in the quick, non-refundable termination of the undersigned's involvement in programming through the New York Institute of Dance and Education.
